Public Hearing - CWSRF Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project Director Emery Penner presented the project description, budget proposal, and repayment of the SRF Loan for the CWSRF Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project. Project will consist of two (2) river crossings, one (1) on the South end of town and one (1) on the North end of town, both have older lines that will be replaced, in one section rebuild older sewer, other area that has old PVC and clay lines will be dug up and replaced. Funding sought after will be SRF with principle forgiveness listed at \$1.575 million which is half of the project cost.

Special Purpose tax will be used to offset the remainder. Application will be submitted on October 10, 2024, will attend the Board meeting in February, plan and start design in the Spring of 2025, go to bid in the winter of 2025 and start construction early in 2026. Will conduct a full environmental study, the town has received comments from federal agencies, Wyoming Game and Fish and ARMY Core Engineers both speak about getting through the proper processes and permits when the project is started. Neither agency has had any red flags come up on the environmental side of the project. No rate change is expected, between the SRF forgiveness and Special Purpose Tax, project should be covered completely.


